The Catholic Migration Office (CMO) is fully qualified and ready to help eligible members of our Haitian community to apply for Temporary Protected Status (TPS) and Employment Authorization. CMO Staff will be available to assist in this effort for the duration of the application period.

In order to apply, you must bring the following:

- Copy of passport and I-94 if any, or birth certificate with English translation (*proving your Haitian nationality*)
- Most recent rent receipts, payroll stubs, bank statements, school, medical and other records (*proving continuous physical presence in the USA since January 12, 2010*)
- Two recent passport style photographs
- \$510.00 in Cash or Money Order payable to Catholic Migration Office (*No Personal Checks, please*)

**IMPORTANT:** If you were arrested, we will need to review all your Certificates of Disposition to determine **if** you are eligible.
