# *Christ Jesus, Our Hope: Parish Strategic Planning Process 2010*

## **Diocese of Brooklyn—Population Projections Report**

*Prepared by the Office of Stewardship and Pastoral Planning April 2010*

### **POPULATION PROJECTIONS**

The Diocese of Brooklyn, encompassing two of the Boroughs of New York, accounts for 59% of the population of New York City.

By the year 2030, the population of New York City is projected to increase by 13.9%.

The Borough of Queens is projected to grow to a new population high of 2,755,948, an increase of 15.1%;

Brooklyn, on the other hand, though remaining the most populous borough, will grow by 10.3%

### **POPULATION GROWTH** is attributable to

a. Natural Increase/Decrease (Births, Deaths)

b. Net Migration (in migration – minus out migration)

**BIRTHS** The number of births in NYC has been declining since 1990. But in 2007, there was an upturn, continuing into 2008.

### **BIRTHS: RACE/ETHNICITY OF MOTHER**

The increase in births, however, was not noted in all groups. Some have been steadily declining, others increasing. For example, the number of births to Puerto Rican mothers has been declining steadily, while the “Other Hispanic” has increased. Similarly, “Other Black” has also declined; “Asian PI” has been increasing. And finally, “Other White” has been in some decline.

### **POPULATION: RACE, HISPANIC ORIGIN**

Comparing the pie charts, one can see clearly, for example, that the white population in Queens, which was 48% of the Borough in 1990, declined to 30% in 2008. Similar changes can be noted for the 4 groups being reported.

### **POPULATION, LIVE BIRTHS, FERTILITY RATES, MARRIAGES, DEATH & INFANT MORTALITY:**

Though the City’s population has been growing since 1990, the number of deaths has been declining, and the death rate is now at 6.5. Also, the infant mortality rate is at an all time low rate of 5.5 (though certain neighborhoods in Brooklyn and Queens have reported much higher rates). Also, Table 2, in the Appendix, notes the decline of marriages in the City, the rate now at 8.0 per 1,000.

### **DIVERSITY OF POPULATION**

Adding to the diversity of the city’s population, but especially in Kings and Queens, has been the ancestry of the birth mother. In Brooklyn, from 1995 through 2008, the highest number of birth mothers has been reported as African-American, followed by Hispanic. But note that in 2008, the Asian group was not far behind. In Queens, for the same period, the Hispanic has maintained first place, with the Asian constantly increasing.

These birth patterns are not surprising when one considers the tremendous shift in the population by Nativity, that is, Native Born versus Foreign Born. In both Queens and Brooklyn, between 1970 and 2008, the Foreign Born population more than doubled.

### **LANGUAGE SPOKEN AT HOME**

As a result, one can note that in Queens, in 2008, 55.1% of those 5 years of age and over, spoke a language other than English at home; in Brooklyn, the percent stood at 45.9%

### **SOME POPULATION CHARACTERISTICS**

**Age**, with emphasis on the school age cohort, and those 65 and over; **Educational attainment of those 25 and over**; and finally, the change in **marital status** (never married, married, separated and divorced, and widowed. The age pyramids indicate that between 2000 and 2030, the bottom of the pyramid will shrink (the under 18 population in Brooklyn from 26.8% to 23.0%); and in Queens, from 22.8% to 20.5%. The top half of the pyramid, on the other hand, will grow, so that in Brooklyn, those over 65 will increase from 12.7% to 14.5%; those over 65 will increase from 11.5% to 15.1%. The median age likewise will go from 35.4 to 37.8 in Brooklyn; and in Queens, from 33.1 to 37.1.

As a result, the share of the school-age and elderly population, which in 1950, was approximately 2:1, will in 2030, be almost 1:1.

Charts show the changes in the school age population, noting that in Queens there will be a slight increase; but in Brooklyn, a slow but steady decline from 478,912 in 2000 to 451,286 in 2030.

### **EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT**

From 1990 through 2008, there has been in both Brooklyn and Queens an increase in the number of those 25 and over who have earned a college degree, be it an associate degree, a bachelors, or a graduate/professional degree. At the same time, the number of those satisfied with only a high school diploma has declined. These charts also indicate the change in each group over the reporting period.

### **MARITAL STATUS**

The “never married” category, both male and female, has steadily increased from 1990 through 2008 in both Kings and Queens. Similarly, the married cohort since 2000 has declined. This information corresponds to the declining number of Marriages reported by the NYC Department of Statistics.
