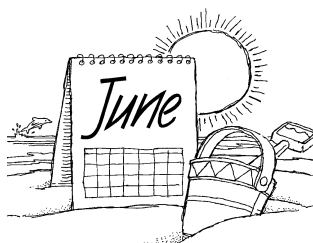

Dear Friends:

Hard on the heels of Memorial Day last weekend, today, June 6, is the commemoration of the Allied invasion of Normandy in World War II, commonly known as "D-Day". This event marked the beginning of the end for Nazi Germany, but only after hundreds of thousands of more deaths of soldiers, civilians and Holocaust victims. We remember those members of "The Greatest Generation" who died or survived, and thank those still among us for their generous efforts to keep the world free.

In our pastoral planning questionnaire, a top parish priority continues to be work with youth. Statistics show that one of the most effective ways of keeping youth connected to the church, after a strong Catholic family, is through Catholic schools. It has been a stated policy of our diocese for several years that every parish without a school of its own should be "aligned" with a neighboring Catholic school. We are happy to announce that after some study, our parish is to be aligned with Most Precious Blood School at Broadway and 36 St. For now our connection will be pastoral (priests' visits, penance services, Masses) and I will serve as a member of the MPB Advisory Board. We look forward to a strengthening of Catholic education in Astoria as a result of the alignment of Mount Carmel parish with MPB School.

In order that our parish may better help support Catholic education opportunity in our area, we are also happy to announce a new addition to the pastoral staff at Mount Carmel: Sister Barbara Buckbee of the Brentwood Sisters of St Joseph will be joining our staff part-time in September as the Catholic School Promoter for the parish. Her work will be to maintain the awareness and opportunity for Catholic school education among our parishioners. Her duties will include: supervising the parish mentors who assist families applying for Catholic schools and financial aid, working with the Mount Carmel School Alumni, and developing new avenues of financial assistance to encourage Catholic school enrollment here. We are delighted to re-establish an official parish connection to the Josephites who founded and staffed our parish school for over a hundred years. Welcome Sister Barbara.

In a similar vein, we are happy to announce the formation of an additional ministry here in our parish. "*Jovenes de Valor*" ("Valiant Youth") is a diocesan bi-lingual youth ministry founded over ten years ago as an offshoot of the charismatic movement, and flourishing in many parishes in Brooklyn and Queens, as well as in the TV program on Diocesan TV entitled "*Too Blessed to be Stressed*". This forms an opportunity distinct from and in addition to the already existing *Jornada* youth group on Friday nights, which has so enriched our parish these last two years. The JDV will meet at SMM on Saturday nights under the supervision of the diocesan staff and adult parishioners from our prayer groups, starting off with a retreat night on Sunday June 27 from 4 to 9 PM. We are happy to offer this opportunity for growth in faith to our young people, in keeping with the priorities outlined in our recent Parish Assembly and parish planning process.

Queridos hermanos,

Después de fin de semana de "Memorial Day", hoy, 06 de junio, es la conmemoración de la invasión aliada de Normandía en la Segunda Guerra Mundial, comúnmente conocido como "D-Day". Este evento marcó el comienzo del fin para los Nazis, pero sólo después de que cientos de miles de más muertes de soldados, los civiles y las víctimas del Holocausto. Recordamos a los que murieron o sobrevivieron, y gracias a los que siguen entre nosotros por su generoso esfuerzo para mantener el mundo libre.

En nuestro cuestionario de planificación pastoral, una prioridad superior parroquia sigue siendo el trabajo con los jóvenes. Las estadísticas muestran que una de las maneras más eficaces de mantener a los jóvenes conectados a la iglesia, después de una familia católica fuerte, es a través de las escuelas católicas. Ha sido una política declarada de nuestra diócesis durante varios años que todas las parroquias sin una escuela propia debe ser "alineados" con una escuela católica vecinos. Estamos felices de anunciar que después de algún estudio, nuestra parroquia ha de ser alineado con la Escuela Preciosísima Sangre en Broadway y 36 St. Para ahora nuestra conexión se pastoral (visitas de los sacerdotes, los servicios de penitencia, las misas) y servirá como un miembro del Consejo Asesor de la Escuela MPB. Esperamos con interés el fortalecimiento de la educación católica en Astoria, como resultado de la alineación de la parroquia Monte Carmelo con la Escuela MPB.

Con el fin de que nuestra parroquia puede ayudar a una mejor oportunidad de apoyar la educación católica en nuestra zona, también estamos felices de anunciar una nueva incorporación a la pastoral de personal en el Monte Carmelo: la Hermana Bárbara Buckbee de las Hermanas de San José de Brentwood se unirá a nuestro equipo de media tiempo en septiembre como el Promotor para Escuelas Católicas de la parroquia. Su trabajo será mantener la conciencia y la oportunidad para la educación escolar católica entre nuestros feligreses. Sus funciones serán: supervisión de los mentores parroquia que ayudar a las familias que soliciten las escuelas católicas y la ayuda financiera, en colaboración con el Monte Carmelo de Antiguos Alumnos, y el desarrollo de nuevas vías de ayuda financiera para fomentar la escolarización católica de aquí. Estamos encantados de volver a establecer una conexión parroquial oficial con Las Monjas Josefinas que fundaron y con personal de nuestra escuela parroquial durante más de cien años. Bienvenido Hermana Bárbara. En la misma línea, nos complace anunciar la formación de un ministerio adicional aquí en nuestra parroquia. "*Jóvenes de Valor*" es una pastoral juvenil diocesana bilingüe fundada hace más de diez años como una rama del movimiento carismático, y floreciente en muchas parroquias en Brooklyn y Queens, así como en el programa de televisión sobre Diocesano de televisión titulado "*Too Blessed to be Stressed*". Esto constituye una oportunidad distinta y, además de la agrupación de jóvenes que ya existen, *Jornada*, el viernes por la noche, que tanto enriqueció a nuestra parroquia en los dos últimos años. El JDV se reunirán en SMM sábados por la noche bajo la supervisión del personal de la diócesis y los feligreses adultos de nuestros grupos de oración, comenzando con un retiro de la noche del domingo 27 de junio 4-9 PM. Estamos encantados de ofrecer esta oportunidad de crecimiento en la fe a nuestros jóvenes, de acuerdo con las prioridades señaladas en nuestra reciente Asamblea Parroquial y el proceso de planificación de la parroquia.
