FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends:

On May 23 after the 11:15 English and 12:30 Spanish Masses, we will have our annual presentation about Catholic Schools in our neighborhood, including information about applying for tuition assistance. If you have school aged children and are interested in Catholic schooling for them, please join us after Mass on those days.

May is the month of Our Blessed Mother, and we honor her especially in the beautiful custom of the May Crowning. As we have done in recent years, the May Crowning will take place on the day after First Holy Communion, on Sunday, May 30 after the 10:00 AM Mass. All the First Communion children are invited to return on that day in their communion clothes and process from church to the statue of Our Lady of Mount Carmel in the parish garden at the end of that mass.

We are preparing the final elements of our parish self-study that we will submit to the diocese by May 18 as part of the Diocesan Strategic Planning effort known as "Christ Jesus, Our Hope". Our self-study will be distributed to parishioners as well when complete. This process is intended not merely to address a current financial crisis through the closing of some parishes, but to be a foundation for renewal of our Catholic mission in Queens and Brooklyn.

Our seminarian Sean Suckiel is now finishing his pastoral year assignment with us. He has become a real part of our parish family, and we trust his final two years of academic study will be enriched by his experiences here. He will be leading a pilgrimage to France from May 10 to 20, and his last Sunday with us will be May 23. We want him to know he will always be welcome to come and visit us when his seminary schedule allows, and that we accompany him with our prayers on his journey to the priesthood. May other young men here in our own parish respond to that call in the future.

*Christ Jesus, Our Hope, A Diocesan Strategic Plan for Renewal :
A Brief Overview of Pastoral Leadership*

As *Christ Jesus, Our Hope, the Diocesan Strategic Planning Process*, goes forward, parish and diocesan leaders will be asked to consider the future of parish life in Brooklyn and Queens. Parish Leadership including priests, deacons, religious sisters and brothers, and lay leaders are critical to carry out the many ministries that are part of Church life.

This report on pastoral leadership examines the current state and future projections of leadership and also considers the ministries that professional church ministers are engaged in and what that might mean for the future.

- There are currently 294 priests assigned to active ministry in the Diocese of Brooklyn. In 2020, the project number of active priests will be 258.
- There are currently 161 retired priests. 45 priests are eligible to retire between 2010 and 2015. 72 priests are eligible to retire between 2016 and 2020 for a total of 148 priests in the next 10 years.
- Currently, religious sisters and brothers continue to minister in education, faith formation, health care and social services. About 15% are retired and volunteer in varied ministries. Many offer part-time service in schools and parishes. The median age for the religious is 70 years.
- Between 2002 and 2008 496 persons from 188 parishes have been commissioned as volunteer lay pastoral leaders. 395 of these lay leaders are actively engaged in ministry.
- Currently 218 lay people are currently part of the 3 year lay formation program.
