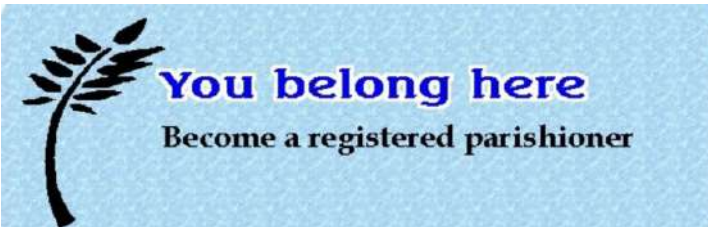

Dear Friends and Parishioners:

Today we offer you the annual **“Parish Report: Part I”** which concerns pastoral activity as reported to the Diocese and to the Holy See in the Vatican. It reflects in a formal way many measurable facets of parish life—its sacraments, catechesis and some lay activity. Of course, no numerical report can capture the fervor, flavor and zeal of parish life, and certainly not the stress of doing it all in a pandemic year. However, it does give us a chance to consider both our achievements and our shortcomings as a parish. I ask you to read this report in the light of remarks in my letter two weeks ago about evangelization, which ought to be the chief priority of the church and its parishes. In that letter I referred to the classic phases of becoming a Christian: **evangelization, catechesis, stewardship, and mission**. In this regard some thoughts from the USCCB evangelization and Catechesis Committee are helpful:

Evangelization is the Church's deepest identity. Evangelization brings the good news of the Gospel to all who seek the life-giving message of faith in Jesus Christ.

Catechesis nourishes, forms and deepens the faith one receives through the ministry of the Church.

Stewardship is an expression of discipleship rooted in a personal relationship with Christ. Good stewards generously share their gifts and blessings with others for the sake of the Kingdom.

The Church is **missionary** by her very nature. Her mission is to proclaim the salvation of Christ to the ends of the earth.

Please read this **“Parish Report: Part I”** through this lens. The **“Parish Report: Part II”** will be the **financial** summary for the past fiscal year in an upcoming bulletin. Thank you for your faith and commitment to Our Lord and our parish.

Please remember the penitential practices of Lent that are listed in the bulletin, the parish website and the *Tablet*. We will conduct Sunday Scripture Studies (in English) via Zoom on Monday nights of Lent from 7:15-8:30 on Feb.15, 22, Mar. 1, 8, 15 & 22. (Mon. Mar. 29 is Reconciliation Monday, so no Scripture Study).

Our diocese has given permission for parishes to resume the normal method of collection-taking at Mass with the following safety protocols in place by the collection-takers: To use a long-handled basket, to wear gloves and to maintain distance. Thus, we will resume this practice starting on Ash Wednesday. Please help our ushers in taking up the collection if they ask you to give them a hand. The drop-boxes for offerings will remain in place at the doors of the church for a transition period.

Queridos amigos y feligreses:

Hoy les ofrecemos el **“Informe Parroquial: Parte I”** anual que se refiere a la actividad pastoral según lo informado a la Diócesis ya la Santa Sede en el Vaticano. Refleja de manera formal muchas facetas mensurables de la vida parroquial: sus sacramentos, la catequesis y alguna actividad laical. Por supuesto, ningún informe numérico puede capturar el fervor, el sabor y el celo de la vida parroquial, y ciertamente no el estrés de hacerlo todo en un año de pandemia. Sin embargo, nos da la oportunidad de considerar tanto nuestros logros como nuestras deficiencias como parroquia. Les pido que lean este informe a la luz de las observaciones de mi carta de hace dos semanas sobre la evangelización, que debería ser la principal prioridad de la iglesia y sus parroquias. En esa carta me refería a las fases clásicas de convertirse en cristiano: **evangelización, catequesis, corresponsabilidad y misión**. En este sentido, algunos pensamientos del Comité de Evangelización y Catequesis de la USCCB son útiles:

- **La evangelización** es la identidad más profunda de la Iglesia. La evangelización trae las buenas nuevas del Evangelio a todos los que buscan el mensaje vivificante de fe en Jesucristo.
- **La catequesis** nutre, forma y profundiza la fe que se recibe a través del ministerio de la Iglesia.
- **La corresponsabilidad (o mayordomía)** es una expresión de discipulado arraigada en una relación personal con Cristo. Los buenos mayordomos comparten generosamente sus dones y bendiciones con los demás por el bien del Reino.
- La Iglesia es **misionera** por naturaleza. Su misión es proclamar la salvación de Cristo hasta los confines de la tierra.

Por favor lea este **“Informe Parroquial: Parte I”** a través de este lente. El **“Informe Parroquial: Parte II”** será el resumen **financiero** del año fiscal pasado en un próximo boletín. Gracias por su fe y compromiso con Nuestro Señor y nuestra parroquia.

Por favor recuerde las prácticas penitenciales de Cuaresma que se enumeran en el boletín, el sitio web de la parroquia y el *Tablet-Nuestra Voz*.

Como ustedes vean, nuestra diócesis ha dado permiso para que las parroquias reanuden el método normal de recolección en la Santa Misa con los siguientes protocolos de seguridad implementados por los recolectores: Usar una canasta de mango largo, usar guantes, y mantener la distancia. Los buzones para las ofrendas permanecerán en las puertas de la iglesia durante un período de transición.

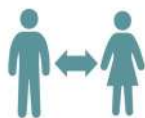
WASH YOUR HANDS
