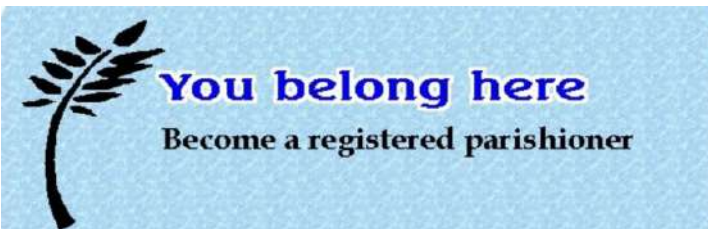

FROM THE OGLE OFFICE

Dear Friends & Parishioners:

During the year 2020 we were able to undertake several construction projects for the replacement, repair, refurbishment and maintenance of several parish facilities needed for the good functioning of our parish. These works were carried out partially by our paid staff, partially by professional contractors and partially by parish volunteers from our Mexican community. Those works included:

- Replacement of 54 year old church A/C units
- Institute new boiler
- Institute meeting rooms rehab
- Gym repainting
- Upper church sacristy
- Lower church sacristy
- Artesian well replacement
- Porch on Hour Children House
- Driveway lights at St Margaret Mary
