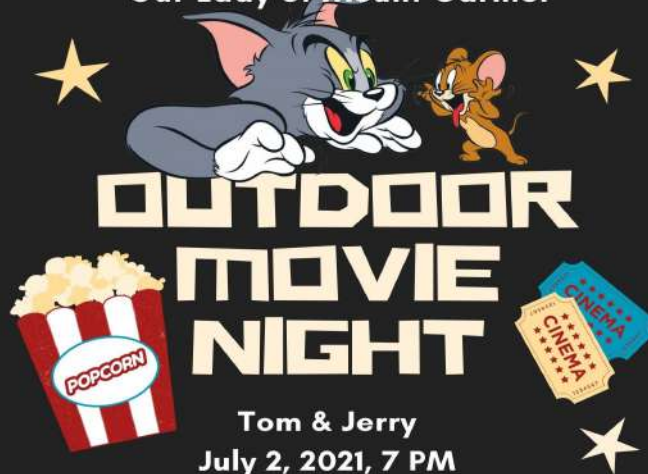

From the Ogle Office

Dear Friends and Parishioners:

This is my last letter to you from the pastor's office here at Mount Carmel and St Margaret Mary. It has been a great thirteen years for me, and I am appreciative of all the encouraging words you have offered me in these last weeks. I know I speak for Father Peter as well when I say that both of us have greatly enjoyed our time here at the "Mother Church of Queens and Long Island", and you will always be in our prayers.

I ask you to give your fullest cooperation in every regard to our new pastor, my friend and colleague Monsignor Cuong Pham. In his visit with our staff and lay leaders last week, he clearly expressed his joy in coming here and his desire to continue strengthening the vibrant life of our parish. He will be a fine shepherd for this parish.

Last week I wrote about the wonderful collaboration with staff and parishioners that brought about such good here. In this letter I want to also express my gratitude to God being a Catholic priest and pastor. No Catholic priest is an independent agent, but rather acts in obedience to the local bishop who ordains and assigns him to various parishes in the local diocesan Church. Thus, I am grateful to the Bishops I have been privileged to work under: to Bishop Francis Mugavero who ordained me in 1977 and assigned me to St Margaret Mary; to Bishop Thomas Daily who made me a pastor and a vicar; and to Bishop DiMarzio who assigned me here thirteen years ago and now sends me on to be a "pastor for the pastors" as Vicar for Clergy, and to help guide the diocesan media efforts. Each of them truly gave me the pastoral agenda that guided my own efforts and those of every diocesan priest during those years. All three have had the hearts of missionaries caring for the immigrants; all three strove to improve and shore up Catholic schools and religious education; all three sought to make our diocese a national leader in pastoral and fiscal professionalism and initiatives.

Bishop DiMarzio in particular has guided some of our most effective efforts here at Mount Carmel. He constantly reminded pastors at our meetings to make sure the RCIA was well-tended, and so we have made it a priority. He asked every parish to have committees in place for both Evangelization and Vocations, and our have been active and effective, in fact gaining diocesan recognition for their model achievements. His capital campaign *Generations of Faith* not only helped fund diocesan pastoral efforts that help us, but enabled us better to restore and repair our beautiful Church. And he brags to groups nationally and internationally about the parish here that has Mass every Sunday in five language (that's us!). And he has maintained his unflinching pastoral efforts during a time of unprecedented cultural, pastoral and personal challenges that might have broken the spirit of a less zealous and committed disciple. So as he draws near the end of his tenure as our chief shepherd, I ask you to keep him in your prayers for a peaceful, healthy and productive retirement when it comes.

Most of all I am mindful of the fact that I have had the privilege of being pastor of two parishes under the protection of Our Blessed Mother: St Mary Star of the Sea in Far Rockaway, and Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Astoria. I am reminded of the prayer of Pope St John Paul II with which he concluded his pastoral letter on the pastoral charity of priests. I ask you to say this prayer often for me and for all priests:

O Mother of Jesus Christ, you were with Christ at the beginning of his life and mission, you sought the Master among the crowd, you stood beside Him when he was lifted up from the earth consumed as the one eternal sacrifice, and you had John, your son, near at hand; accept from the beginning those who have been called, protect their growth, in their life ministry accompany your sons, O Mother of Priests. Amen.

Queridos Amigos y Feligreses:

Esta es mi última carta para usted desde la oficina del pastor aquí en Mount Carmel y Sta Margarita María. Han sido trece años maravillosos para mí y agradezco todas las palabras de aliento que me han ofrecido en estas últimas semanas. Sé que hablo en nombre del Padre Peter también cuando digo que ambos hemos disfrutado mucho de nuestro tiempo aquí en la "Iglesia Madre de Queens y Long Island", y siempre estarás en nuestras oraciones.

Les pido que brinden su más completa cooperación en todos los aspectos a nuestro nuevo pastor, mi amigo y colega Monseñor Cuong Pham. En su visita a nuestro personal y líderes laicos la semana pasada, expresó claramente su alegría por venir aquí y su deseo de continuar fortaleciendo la vibrante vida de nuestra parroquia. Será un buen pastor para esta parroquia.

La semana pasada escribí sobre la maravillosa colaboración con el personal y los feligreses que trajo tanto éxito aquí. En esta carta también quiero expresar mi gratitud a Dios por ser un sacerdote y pastor católico. Ningún sacerdote católico es un agente independiente, sino que actúa en obediencia al obispo local que lo ordena y asigna a varias parroquias en la Iglesia diocesana local. Por lo tanto, estoy agradecido a los obispos con los que he tenido el privilegio de trabajar: al obispo Francis Mugavero, que me ordenó en 1977 y me asignó a Santa Margarita María; al obispo Thomas Daily, quien me nombró pastor y vicario; y al Obispo DiMarzio, quien me asignó aquí hace trece años y ahora me envía como "pastor de los pastores" como Vicario para el Clero, y para ayudar a guiar los esfuerzos de los medios diocesanos. Cada uno de ellos realmente me dio la agenda pastoral que guió mis propios esfuerzos y los de cada sacerdote diocesano durante esos años. Los tres han tenido el corazón de misioneros que cuidan a los inmigrantes; los tres se esforzaron por mejorar y apuntalar las escuelas católicas y la educación religiosa; los tres buscaron hacer de nuestra diócesis un líder nacional en iniciativas y profesionalismo pastoral y fiscal.

El obispo DiMarzio en particular ha guiado algunos de nuestros esfuerzos más efectivos aquí en el Monte Carmelo. Constantemente recordaba a los pastores en nuestras reuniones que se aseguraran de que el RICA estuviera bien atendido, por lo que lo hemos convertido en una prioridad. Pidió a todas las parroquias que tuvieran comités para la evangelización y las vocaciones, y los nuestros han sido activos y efectivos, de hecho, obtuvieron el reconocimiento diocesano por sus logros modelo. Su campaña capital *Generations of Faith* no solo ayudó a financiar los esfuerzos pastorales diocesanos que nos ayudan, sino que nos permitió restaurar y reparar mejor nuestra hermosa Iglesia. Y se jacta ante grupos a nivel nacional e internacional sobre la parroquia aquí que tiene la Santa Misa todos los domingos en cinco idiomas (¡eso somos nosotros!). Y ha mantenido sus incansables esfuerzos pastorales durante una época de desafíos culturales, pastorales y personales sin precedentes que podrían haber roto el espíritu de un discípulo menos celoso y comprometido. Así que a medida que se acerca el final de su mandato como nuestro pastor principal, les pido que lo mantengan en sus oraciones por una jubilación pacífica, saludable y productiva cuando llegue.

Sobre todo, soy consciente del hecho de que he tenido el privilegio de ser párroco de dos parroquias bajo la protección de Nuestra Santísima Madre: Santa María Estrella del Mar en Far Rockaway y Nuestra Señora del Monte Carmelo en Astoria. Recuerdo la oración del Papa San Juan Pablo II con la que concluyó su carta pastoral sobre la caridad pastoral de los sacerdotes. Les pido que digan esta oración a menudo por mí y por todos los sacerdotes:

Oh Madre de Jesucristo, estuviste con Cristo al comienzo de su vida y misión, buscaste al Maestro entre la multitud, estuviste junto a Él cuando fue levantado de la tierra consumido como el único sacrificio eterno, y tuviste a Juan, tu hijo, al alcance de la mano; acepta desde el principio a los que han sido llamados, protege su crecimiento, en su ministerio de vida acompaña a tus hijos, oh Madre de los sacerdotes. Amén.
