English Baptism Instructions take place the Saturday (at 10:00am via Zoom) and Tuesday (at 7:00pm in person) before the date of Baptism at Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Parents and Godparents baptizing their children at other parishes but taking the classes here must call to register for the class at least a week before the class. We remind parents and godparents to inform us if they will be unable to attend the pre-Baptismal class they registered for. Private baptisms are not celebrated unless the family has a priest or deacon friend who will perform the ceremony. If you have any questions please call the parish office.

From the Ogle Office

Dear Friends and Parishioners:

Most of us have childhood memories of special family meals when we experienced the joyful and solemn moments of family life and love around the dinner table. God made us for that kind of sharing, and He made it the vehicle for the supreme act of Christian worship, the paschal banquet and sacrifice of the Holy Mass.

Recently, Bishop DiMarzio announced that many (but not all) the restrictive practices of the pandemic can now be ended in the light of CDC and NY State restrictions being lifted due to widespread vaccinations and growing immunity. In our parish we implemented these practices the weekend of May 29-30 (Memorial Day weekend.)

In light of all this, in the Brooklyn Diocese the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass which has been in effect since the start of the pandemic will be lifted as of the weekend of June 5-6, the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). Those who are ill, or feeling unwell, those who care for the sick, and those themselves at risk, are automatically dispensed from the obligation, as has always been the case. It is up to each individual to weigh their own circumstances through an examination of their conscience and determine, by use of their conscience, whether or not they are excused from the Sunday obligation. A well-formed conscience is upright and truthful.

Thus, we encourage you to give serious consideration to returning to in-person Mass attendance. First of all, it is a moral obligation that God Himself gave us in the Ten Commandments. That truth cannot be lightly dismissed. Secondly, just as a family draws strength when united around the family dinner table, so too we Christians draw strength at the table of the Lord's Supper. The advantages of personal participation in the liturgy are manifest, primarily through physical reception of the Holy Eucharist. The effects of regular reception of Holy Communion are fruitful and even miraculous. As the Catechism teaches us, those effects are to strengthen us in five ways:

- In our unity with Christ
- In our will to resist sin
- In our communion with other Christians
- In our awareness of the needs of the less fortunate
- And... worthy reception of the Eucharist forgives our venial sins.

Therefore; how could we bear NOT to receive Him when it signifies such immense love for us? How could we bear NOT to receive him when it signifies the complete union with the Creator that we were originally made for? How could we NOT receive Him when it signifies that ultimate and eternal union with Him and with our Faithful Departed in life eternal? As the NY State Bishops have said in their statement on attending Mass: "More than an obligation, it is a remarkable opportunity— one not to be missed."

By attending Mass personally we also building a sense of community, worship with the people of God, and experience the joy of communal worship. Safety-wise, our church is now equipped with a brand new ventilation system and filters and U-V germicide lights, observes all possible protective protocols, and is disinfected daily. Please seriously consider returning to the family table of the Lord every Sunday.

As per the Bishop's directives and our own positive experience with livestreaming, we will continue doing it. It is a valuable tool for reaching out to the homebound, the inaccessible and even to the alienated and unchurched, and we will continue the practice here. Many people who do attend Mass in person tell me they also watch our livestream because they just love seeing our parish in action. However, it must be remembered that watching a livestreamed mass does not fulfill the moral obligation to attend Sunday Mass for a person who is otherwise not impeded from attending Mass in person.

Queridos Amigos y Feligreses:

Estimados amigos y feligreses: La mayoría de nosotros tenemos recuerdos de la infancia de comidas familiares especiales cuando experimentamos los momentos alegres y solemnes de la vida familiar y el amor alrededor de la mesa. Dios nos hizo para ese tipo de compartir, y lo convirtió en el vehículo para el acto supremo del culto cristiano, el banquete pascual y el sacrificio de la Santa Misa.

Recientemente, el obispo DiMarzio anunció que muchas (pero no todas) las prácticas restrictivas de la pandemia ahora pueden terminar a la luz del levantamiento de las restricciones de los CDC y del estado de Nueva York debido a las vacunas generalizadas y la creciente inmunidad. En nuestra parroquia implementamos estas prácticas el fin de semana del 29 al 30 de mayo (fin de semana del Día de los Caídos).

A la luz de todo esto, en la Diócesis de Brooklyn se levantará la dispensa de la obligación de asistir a la misa dominical vigente desde el inicio de la pandemia a partir del fin de semana del 5 al 6 de junio, la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo (Corpus Christi). Los enfermos o los malestares, los que cuidan de los enfermos y los que están en situación de riesgo, quedan automáticamente dispensados de la obligación, como siempre ha sido el caso. Depende de cada individuo sopesar sus propias circunstancias mediante un examen de conciencia y determinar, mediante el uso de su conciencia, si están o no exentos de la obligación dominical. Una conciencia bien formada es recta y veraz.

Por lo tanto, lo alentamos a que considere seriamente regresar a la asistencia a Santa Misa en persona. En primer lugar, es una obligación moral que Dios mismo nos dio en los Diez Mandamientos. Esa verdad no puede descartarse a la ligera. En segundo lugar, así como una familia se fortalece cuando se une alrededor de la mesa de la cena familiar, así también los cristianos sacamos fuerzas en la mesa de la Cena del Señor. Las ventajas de la participación personal en la liturgia se manifiestan principalmente a través de la recepción física de la Sagrada Eucaristía. Los efectos de la recepción regular de la Sagrada Comunión son fructíferos e incluso milagrosos. Como nos enseña el Catecismo, esos efectos nos fortalecen de cinco maneras:

- En nuestra unidad con Cristo
- En nuestra voluntad de resistir el pecado
- En nuestra comunión con otros cristianos
- En nuestra conciencia de las necesidades de los menos afortunados
- Y... la recepción digna de la Eucaristía perdona nuestros pecados veniales.

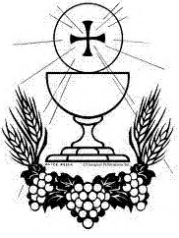
Por lo tanto; ¿Cómo podríamos soportar NO recibirlo cuando significa un amor tan inmenso por nosotros? ¿Cómo podríamos soportar NO recibirlo cuando significa la unión completa con el Creador para el que fuimos creados originalmente? ¿Cómo podríamos NO recibirlo cuando significa esa unión suprema y eterna con Él y con nuestros Fieles Difuntos en la vida eterna? Como han dicho los obispos del estado de Nueva York en su declaración sobre la asistencia a misa: "Más que una obligación, es una oportunidad extraordinaria, una que no debe perderse".

Al asistir a Misa personalmente, también construimos un sentido de comunidad, adoramos con el pueblo de Dios y experimentamos el gozo de la adoración comunitaria. En cuanto a la seguridad, nuestra iglesia ahora está equipada con un nuevo sistema de ventilación y filtros y luces germicidas U-V, observa todos los protocolos de protección posibles y se desinfecta a diario. Considere seriamente regresar a la mesa familiar del Señor todos los domingos.

De acuerdo con las directivas del obispo y nuestra propia experiencia positiva con la transmisión en vivo, continuaremos haciéndolo. Es una herramienta valiosa para llegar a los confinados en casa, los inaccesibles e incluso los alienados y sin iglesia, y continuaremos la práctica aquí. Muchas personas que asisten a Misa en persona me dicen que también ven nuestra transmisión en vivo porque les encanta ver nuestra parroquia en acción. 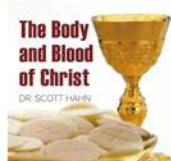
